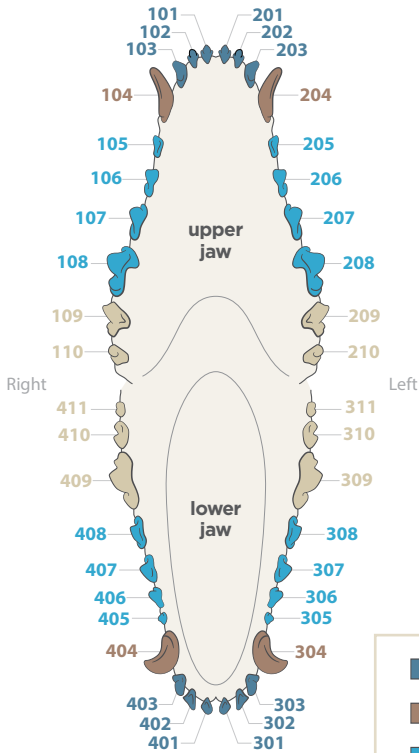

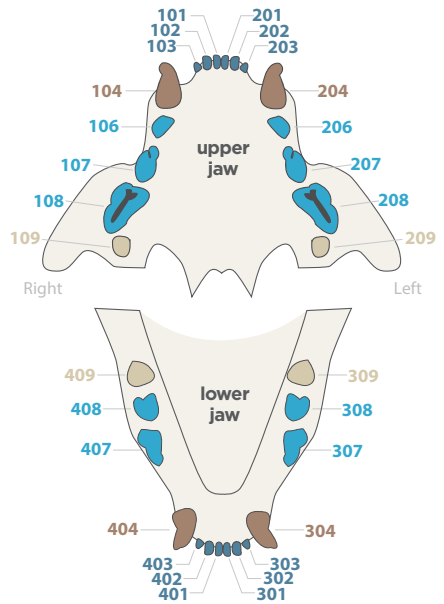

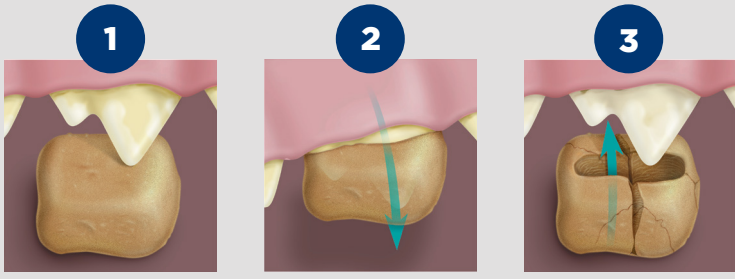

Brush up on at-home teeth cleanings

Combined with an effective dental food and annual (or more frequent) checkups, regular brushings can make a huge difference in your pet's dental health. See our best brushing tips:

1. Introduce the toothpaste

Using a finger toothbrush or index finger wrapped in gauze, gently rub your pet's teeth AND gums. Pet toothpaste, chicken broth or tuna juice can help.

2. Begin brushing

Brush gently, finishing with the bottom front teeth. Focus on any cheek-facing teeth as they are most prone to tartar buildup.

3. Reward!

Getting used to brushing can take time, so be patient and make sure to reward and praise your pet with each attempt.
